§ 5-39-203 - Criminal trespass.

5-39-203. Criminal trespass.

- (a) A person commits criminal trespass if he or she purposely enters or remains unlawfully in or upon:
- (1) A vehicle; or
- (2) The premises of another person.
- **(b)** Criminal trespass is a:
- (1) Class B misdemeanor if the vehicle or premises involved is an occupiable structure; or
- (2) Class C misdemeanor if otherwise committed.
